Villa Puccini has a clear fruity aromas of cherry, violets and fresh spices. Hints of oak, vanilla and a little light licorice. The taste is full-bodied with flavors of ripe cherries, dishes and fresh spices. Long aftertaste.

One of the most famous producers Castellani family with its famous wine Villa Puccini.. Villa Puccini is made of 90 percent sangiovese, which is great Tuscan grape, and ten percent merlot. After viniferingen stored wine for twelve months in small oak barrels that give much oak character and elegance. Villa Puccini is usually described as an Italian contemporary "super blend ". The mixture contained ten percent Merlot, which gives hints of black currant, ripe cherry and raspberry. Villa Puccini mixed after separate fermentation of sangiovese and merlot. Villa Puccini is a wine composed of Italian cuisine with their signature dishes such as fresh pasta, pizza and the area's famous Pecoriniost. It can advantageously be drunk to cured meats such as Parma ham and salami and tasty meat dishes and strong cheeses. It is a very versatile wine with powerful flavors. Villa Puccini develop over a few years of aging, but it is advisable to drink now.
